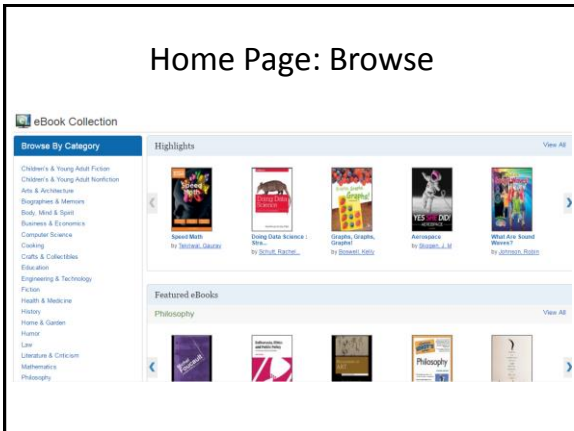

Refine Results

Current Search parameters

Limiters

- Full Text, Download Available, Exclude Abridged Titles, Publication Date
- Show More opens Search Options window

Facets

- Narrow search by Source Type, Subject, Publisher, Language, and/or Category

Results List: Display Options

Sort order: Default is Relevance

- Date Newest, Date Oldest, Author, or Title

Page Options

- Result Format: Standard, Brief (default), Title Only, or Detailed
- Image Quick View: On (default) or Off
- Results per page: 5, 10, 20 (default), 30, 40, or 50
- Page Layout: column and sidebar selections

Note: Display Options are "sticky" for session

Results List: Share Options

Add to folder

- All results on page or to custom folder

Create an alert

- Email alert: need to sign in to EBSCO account
- RSS feed: copy syndication feed link

Use Permalink

- Requires login/authentication to view

Citation includes bibliographic information and, when available:

- Series link to other titles in the series
- Author(s) and Subject(s) may be links to perform a search on that term
- Publisher Permissions
- Concurrent User Level
- Most Relevant Pages
- Table of Contents

Detailed Record: Tools Menu

-  Add to folder Add to session folder (temporary) or EBSCO account folder
-  Print Print the citation
-  E-mail Email to one or multiple addresses
-  Save Save the citation to your computer
-  Cite Citation information available in different formats
-  Export Export to bibliographic management software
-  Create Note Save a note on the article in your EBSCO account folder
-  Permalink Copy and paste a persistent link to the article
-  Share Share article link on Facebook, Twitter, etc.

Across top of page:



- See Publisher Permissions for Save / Email limits
- Use ... to display full tools menu
- Download available while reading online

Along bottom of page:

- Full Screen View, Fit Page Width, Fit Page, Zoom
- < Current Page Number > and current chapter Title

To read online:

1. Select chapter or section title
2. Use page < > or enter page #

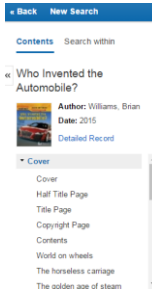
OR... keyboard mouse controls

3. Use scroll bar on right
4. OR... Use keyboard up/down arrows to scroll; left right arrows to page through; or mouse scroll

Read Online: EPUB

EPUB is an open eBook format

- All text and illustrative material is included but is not an exact image
- Allows for increasing font size to optimize reading on different devices
- Uses vertical scrolling (not page numbers) to display each chapter
- **Contents:** Table of Contents opens
- **Search within:** opens search box



Read Online: EPUB

Across top of page:

- Same toolbar as PDFs

Along bottom of page:



- Fit page to Viewport: fit the entire page to view area
- Zoom in or out to decrease or increase font size
- Chapter navigation arrows to change chapter/section

Read Online: EPUB

To read online: Only chapter scrolling is available!

1. Select chapter or section title to scroll through it
2. Use chapter navigation < > to change chapter
3. Use scroll bar on right to scroll through chapter



4. OR.... Use keyboard up/down arrows or mouse to scroll

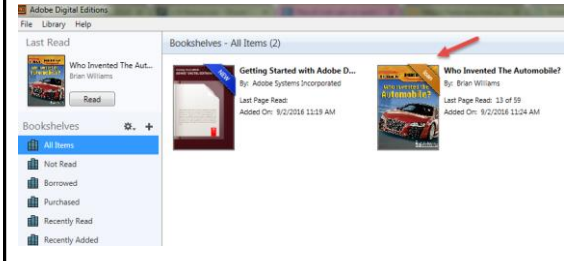

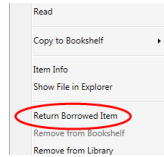

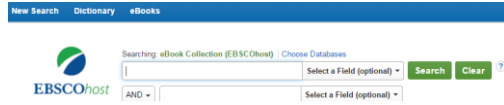

Search History

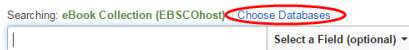
Basic Search Advanced Search **Search History**
