 - Science

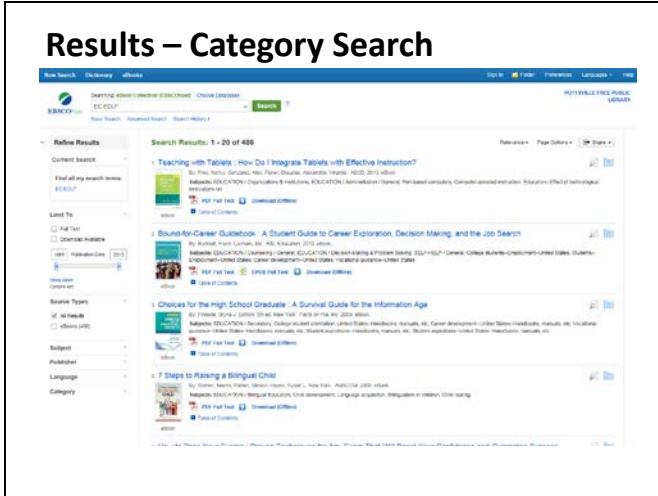

eBook Collection Category Screen

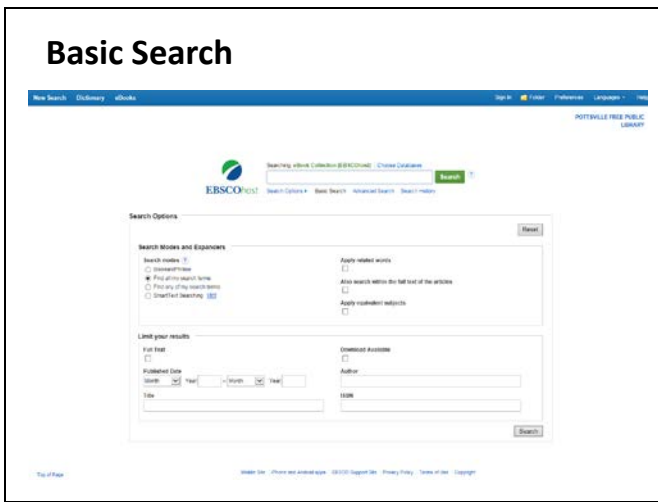

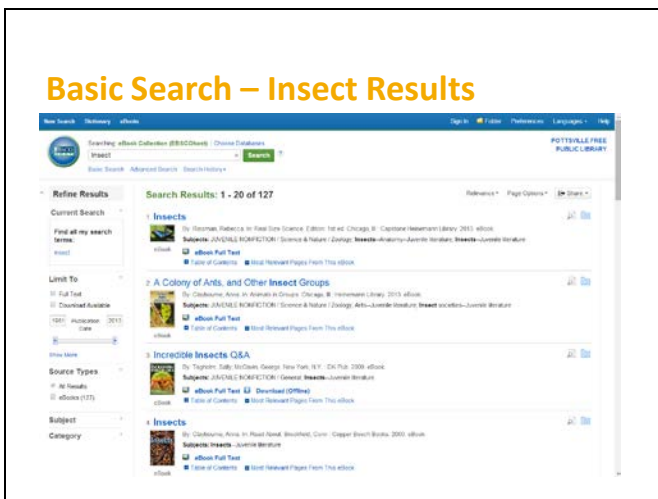



The right navigation pane contains all the tools that are available in the Detailed Record. These tools include:


- Add to folder

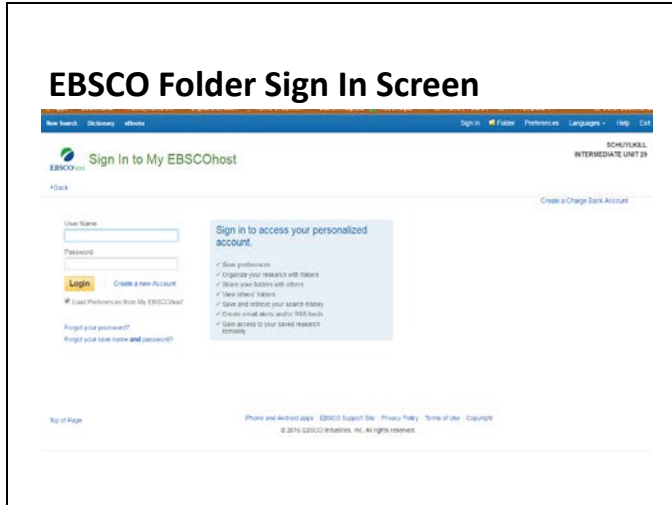
Downloading eBooks

- Downloading instructions will be different depending on the device you are using.

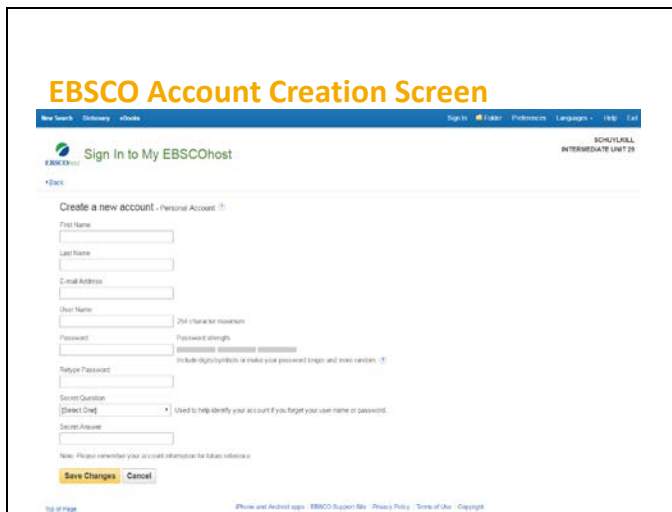

Downloading to a Mobile Device

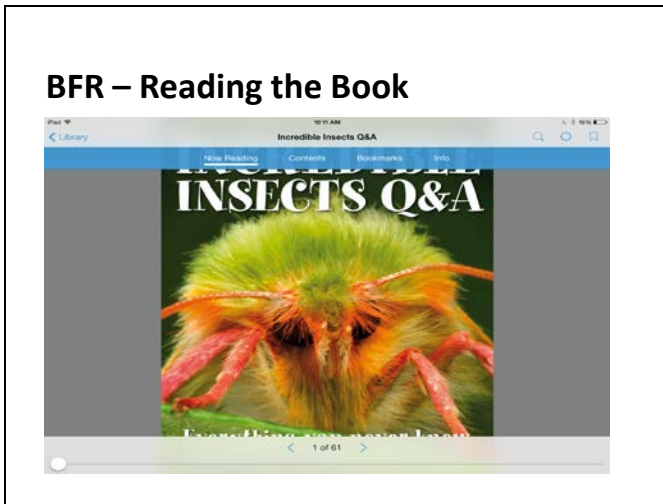
- When downloading to a mobile device you will need the **Bluefire Reader** app installed on the device.

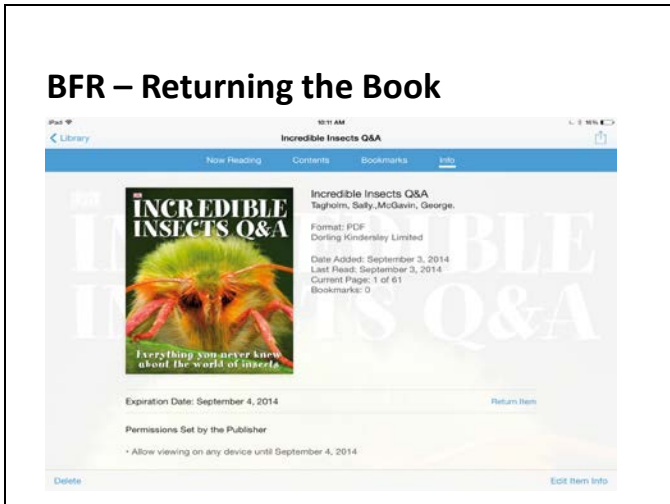
